Community Transit is a private, non-profit organization that provides reliable, affordable, transportation to residents of Delaware County through their mission “to increase the mobility and independence of senior citizens, and persons with disabilities.” Community Transit’s service is available to **everyone in Delaware County** for any trip purpose. The Senior Shared Ride Program is a reduced fare transportation program available to riders age 65 and older who are willing to share their trip with other passengers. Community Transit is also the county-designated administrator for

the Medical Assistance Transportation Program in Delaware County. ACCESS card holders may call 610-490-3975 for more information. Under the PwD program, transportation is available for people with disabilities, age 18-64 who need transportation from an area not served by existing transportation services. Passengers must become registered with Community Transit by calling their office at 610-490-3977 or by visiting their website at www.ctdelco.org. Once registered, passengers can begin scheduling trips by calling 610-490-3960. Trip requests are accepted up to 12 noon, one day in advance, as availability permits. All trips are reserved on a first-come, first-served basis and rides are available as capacity and ride-sharing allow.
